# Review: Demo with Randall Higman

When younger, Randall Higdon was an impatient painter. He discovered he liked the immediacy of watercolor.

Rand began his art career in graphic design as an art director; however the constant deadline crises began to undermine his enthusiasm for that profession. He quit his job in 1978 to create art full time.

Randy prefers to paint on Crescent or Arches cold press boards. The water and paint move around more – they don't sink in so there is more saturation of color. He goes dense on color, establishing contrast. His paintings come alive by use of value opposition, large and small masses, clean and dirty color, warm and cool color, detail and no detail. When painting Randy tries to get

as much done in one sitting rather than waiting for it to dry and adding another layer. He uses the permanent Sheva



casein to lighten areas and white. Colorless masking fluid is also used to create whites.

Some advice Randy received when younger – don't make deadlines a negative element. "The way you paint is an expression of your personality"
