Steve Johnson had a 40-year career in the advertising field as a graphic designer, illustrator and art director in our area. He retired in 2001 to pursue a career in painting, rustic furniture design, graphic design and illustration. As a self-taught artist, he's painted for 40 years using northern Indiana interests, from Amish farmsteads to local historic landmarks, as subjects.

Steve uses transparent watercolor as his

main medium in the painting process. Recently he's begun using oils to explore the creative process.

Steve strives to represent his paintings in an honest and straight forward manner, while trying to give the viewer an accurate feel of the temperature, atmosphere and mood of that particular moment.
